World Scout Jamboree Grants – Application Process

This is the application process devised by the nominated member for the above programme. The process will be reviewed by the Grants Sub-Committee and the Jamboree Management Team following the conclusion of the application and selection process and again following the conclusion of the 25th World Scout Jamboree in 2023.

Application

Applications will be made using the online Typeform or the paper form returned by email to the Jamboree Grants mailbox or by post to County Office. Applications will be logged on a central database (not on ScoutHub).

Interviews

All applicants (or the parents of young people) will be invited to a Zoom call to discuss the circumstances surrounding their application and given the opportunity to add detail to be passed onto the Grants Sub-Committee. Interviews are not compulsory, but the Grants Sub-Committee will be told who refused an interview.

Decision Making

An anonymised list of applicants will be presented to the Grants Sub-Committee, along with the notes surrounding the applications, to be assessed following the process defined by the chair of the committee and in line with the sub-committee's 'Policy, Procedure and Programmes' document.
