Julie Mair

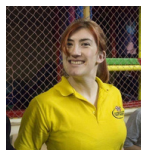
A firm fixture of Scouting in the New Forest, Julie is bossing it by reminding Andy of all the things he's forgotten and feeding a good section of the core team and Network.

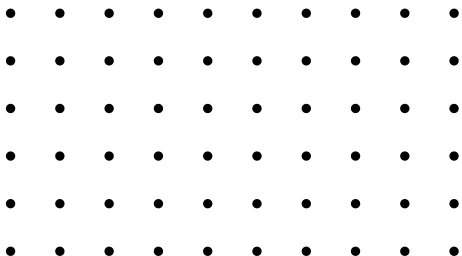
Brain Teaser

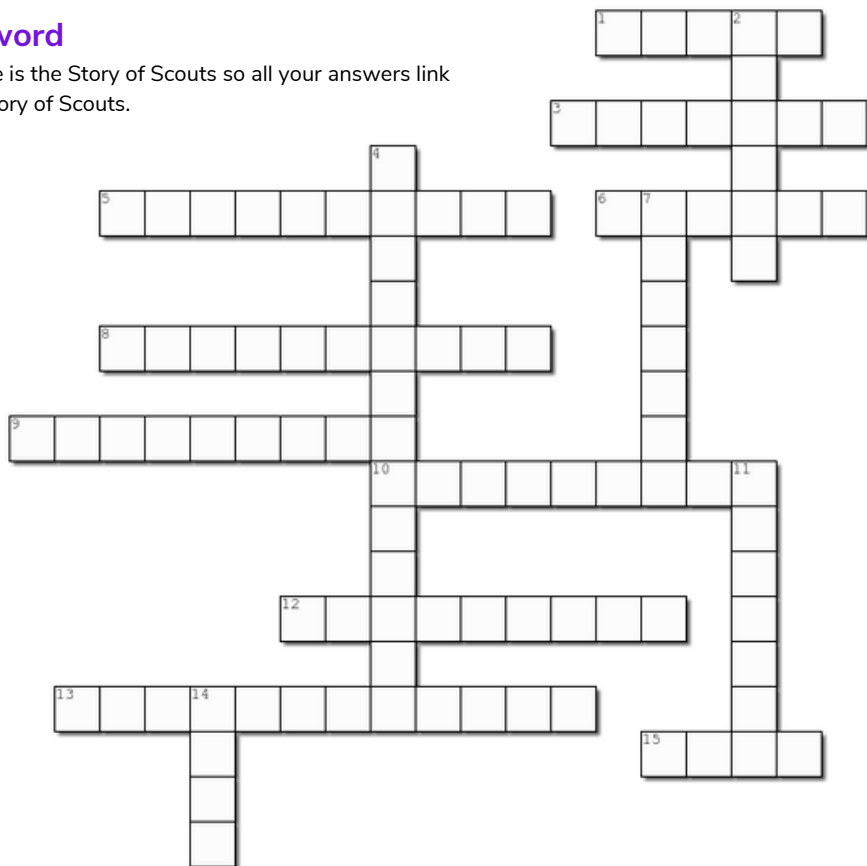

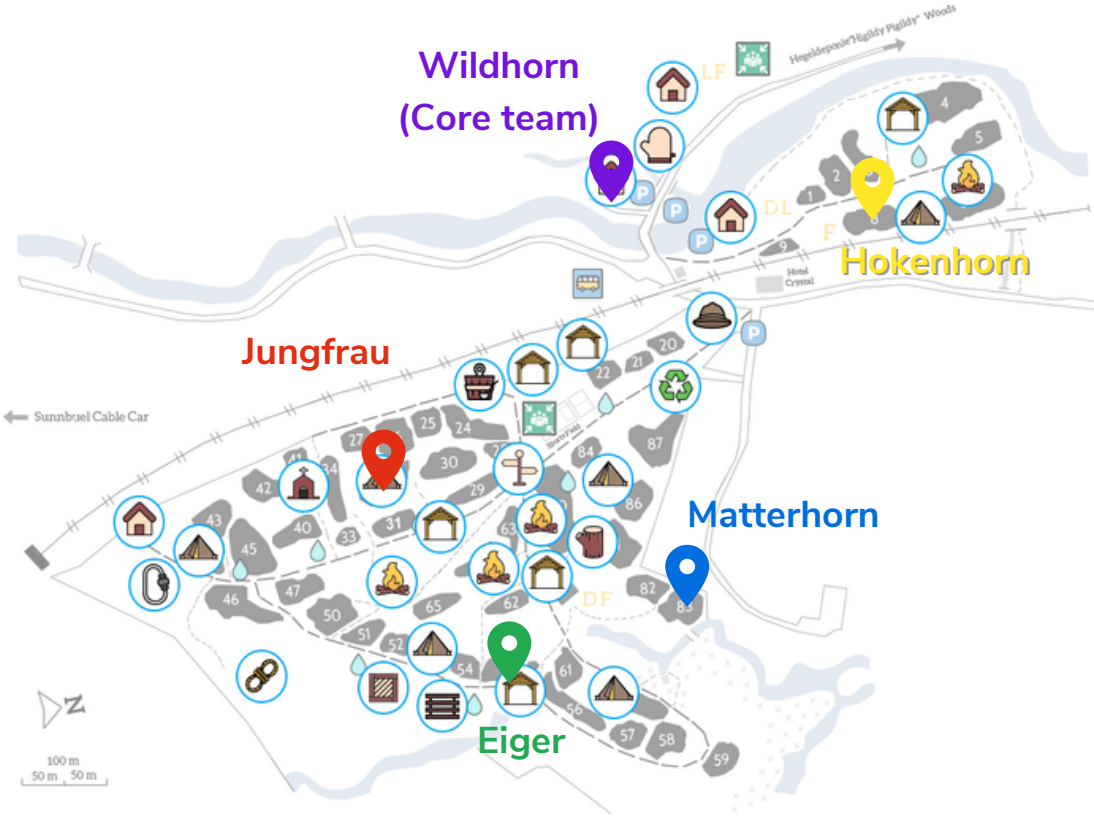
