

Our adventurers went canyoning this morning in Interlaken. This involved a series of slides and jumps into the canyon whilst making their way down it. The highest jump was around 9 metres.



Mountain bikes

Some of the Swiss Adventurers hired mountain bikes and took them for a ride around Kandersteg, they enjoyed a range of cycling through the village of Kandersteg, up the hills surrounding hills as well as going into the woods for some off-road adventures. As they grouped they climbed up some of the steep roads on the bikes before descending at high speeds back down the road. Including hitting a record of 32Kmh on the speedometer on a flat piece of road.



Seeking high adventure, nine members of camp took to the rocks to clamber along a Via Ferrata path attached by harness but not limiting the stunning views. With adrenaline racing, it was a great introduction. Later, they visited the Adventure Park in Adelboden to experiene the thrills of multiple zip-lines across the river and high level crossings under the road bridge. And if that wasn't enough, they stepped off the bridge into the unknown with only a line to slow their descent.


Puzzles


