Very cool! After two trains up to Jungfrauoch our adventurers got to explore a part of the Aletsch glacier - largest in the alps.

Following the guided route, they got to see phenomenal views from an observatory above the glacier and the opportunity to zip line above it.

The restaurant offered a chance to sit and take in the view while having lunch. Next door was a Swiss Lindt chocolate shop which also featured an interactive display of how the chocolate is produced.

Our adventurers were also able to walk out onto snow paths above the glacier to see the views from different angles.

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Inside the glacier the adventures found an ice palace which consisted of carefully carved tunnels and rooms. As they explored, they saw icesculptures of penguins, polar bears, pianos and much more!!



Canyoning

After abseiling 50 meters into the Grimsel Canyon, 18 of our adventurers took on the challenge of going Advanced Canyoning.

They enjoyed a day of jumping down waterfalls, sliding down rock faces and enjoying lunch surrounded by the Canyon.

This is all before finishing the day by zooming down a zip wire, letting go and landing into a lake below them ending the day with a splash!



Chaligang Via Ferrata and adventure park

A group of our adventurers took a trip to Chaligang where they were taught the skills on how to climb a Ferrata before putting their actions into good use and ascending the Ferrata.

As a group, they climb up alongside the waterfall where they hit the amazing heights whilst admiring the views of Adelboden whilst they climbed.

After having lunch, whilst overlooking the waterfall, the group took a trip to the Adelboden adventure park where the group hit high speeds whilst zooming through the zip wires at various heights as well as testing out their fear of heights when jumping from 25 meters up.



Ueschinen Hut Hike & Climb

A group of the Adventurers have set off on their overnight stay at the Ueschinen Hut. They will have spent the day hiking up to the hut, spent the night admiring the views of the surrounding Swiss alps before partaking in a climbing course this morning.



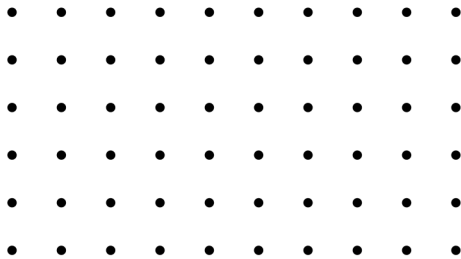
Puzzles

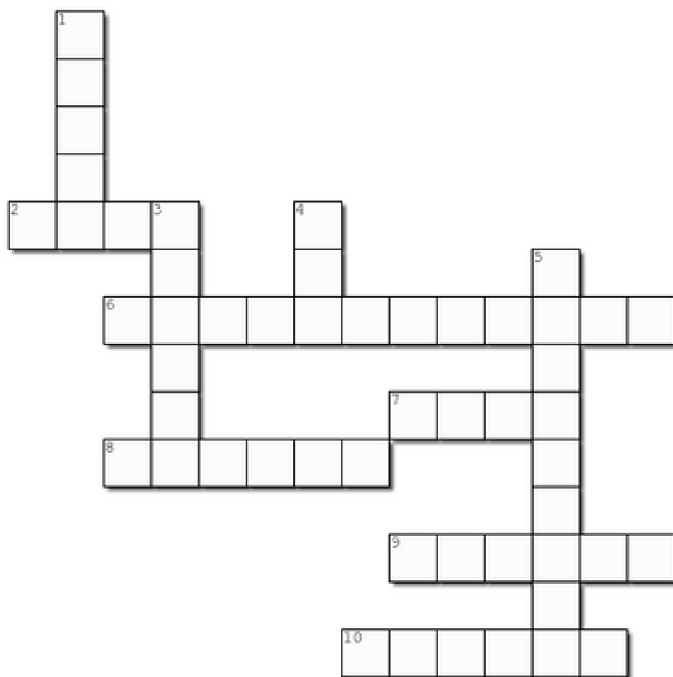

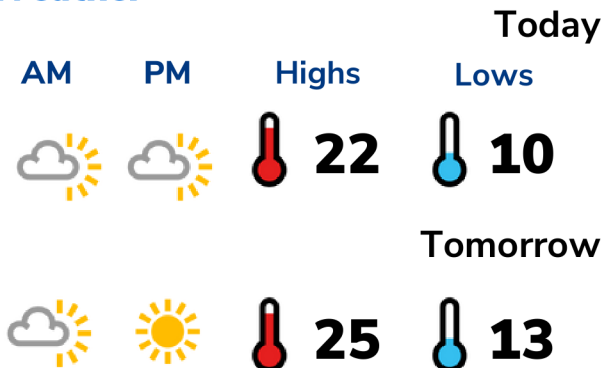
Keeping well

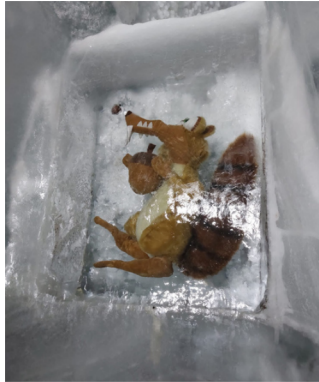
